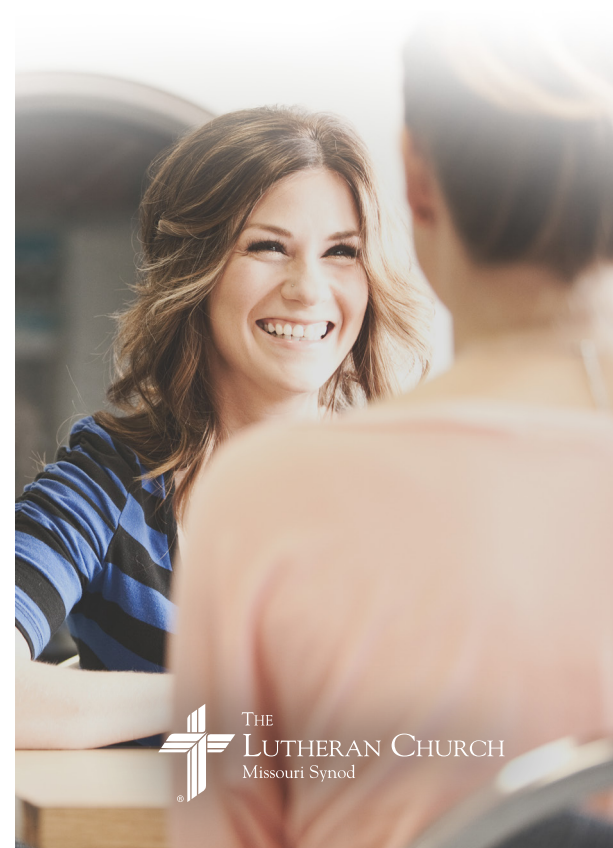

Witness is the purpose
of your everyday life.

The *Every One His Witness*® Lutheran evangelism program considers your place as a witness of Christ within your daily context. It connects sound doctrine with practical ways to share the faith with those whom God has placed alongside you in your everyday life.

It starts with the core module.

Every One His Witness® uses the ‘LASSIE’ approach to witnessing, which is a relational, contextual approach that teaches you to share the Good News of Jesus Christ as you Listen, Ask, Seek, Share, Invite and Encourage people in your life who are not yet part of the church.

Learn to witness in specific contexts.

After the core module workshop, register online at everyonehiswitness.org to gain access to the video-based context modules. These modules pick up where the core module left off, teaching you how to witness in specific contexts. Once you’ve completed a context module course, participate in the online discussion forum to support and encourage other witnesses in that context.
